

Camp Fuego Information

Checklist:

- Extra spending money for meals on travel days (min \$40 suggested)

Cell Phone Policy:

Students may have their phones on the bus. Phones will be put in a lockbox when we arrive at camp. They will be returned on Thursday evening for the purpose of charging and so they can get contact information from new friends on Friday. Parents you can reach your student by contacting one of the adults. If a student needs to call home, we will gladly allow them to use an adult's phone with no questions asked.

Packing list

- comfy/causal day-to-day attire—pack for about 7 seven days
- clothes for services if that's your thing
- activewear for Fuego Fun/Late Night Rec
- Paint War attire (anything you're okay with getting covered in paint + maybe some goggles, shower cap, etc.)
- Theme Night Attire:
 - **Monday:** Tailgate: Come in your fav sports team attire - think jerseys, hats, eye black, foam fingers, etc.
 - **Tuesday:** Christmas in Hawaii - Mele Kalikimaka! Come dressed in your best Christmas/Hawaiian attire!
 - **Wednesday:** FueGLO: Wear anything that will show up under blacklights - neon, white, glow sticks, etc.
- Shoes: comfy/casual, closed toed shoes for rec, shower shoes
- swimsuit, shirt for over swimsuit (required for both guys & gals), & beach towel
- Modest pajamas
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste

- Hair stuff
- DEODORANT....PLEASE!!
- Sunscreen
- Soap
- 2 towels
- 2 washcloths (or loofa)
- pillow
- sleeping bag and sheets or blanket (We will be sleeping on the floor on Sunday night. You will want more than just a sheet for that.)
- Bible, notebook, pen
- sunscreen, bug spray
- wristwatch (NO SMARTWATCHES)
- reusable water bottle
- plastic bag for packing up wet things
- snacks/snack money (All main meals are provided, but you're welcome to bring your own snacks and/or money to buy snacks from the facilities where we host camp!)

From Camp Fuego--

Do NOT pack clothes that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations
- Is excessively short or tight fitting (Avoid "Cheer" Shorts, crop tops, etc.).

While at camp, we ask students and adults:

- Wear closed-toed shoes to rec.
- Wear a t-shirt over swimwear at the pool (both guys & girls).
- Wear modest shorts, skirts, leggings or jeans.
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to their underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands, etc.)
- Wear a dark t-shirt if you plan to take part in the messy games or water games (We use a lot of water...It's Louisiana and its summer).

Other Info:

- T-shirt printing: The camp printshop will sell you a shirt, but you can also get them to print on one of the shirts you already own for cheaper.
- Don't be a dummy: Follow all rules (they are mostly for your safety), respect leaders, respect other campers, don't cause or chase drama, don't do stupid things that require a parent call.

Packing Logistics:

- Carry on the bus:
 - Small bag or backpack with a change of clothes and needed toiletries
 - Pillow
- Underneath the bus:
 - Your suitcase for the week (does **NOT** come off the bus on Sunday)
 - Sleeping bag (this is the only item that will be taken out from under the bus on Sunday night)
