CFBC 30-Day Prayer Guide



An Invitation to Intercede for Your Pastor and Revive Your Church

Join our Elders, Deacons, and staff in a focused season of prayer for our Pastor and Church Staff for the sake of revival and spiritual awakening in our church and beyond. Our desire is to lift up our leaders in prayer asking God not only to do a mighty work in their hearts but in all our hearts. We want to see God empower and transform our pastor, staff, and church body to accomplish greater things than we can ask or think. Ephesians 3:20

May 1st – Focus: Relationship with God

Lord God, give our pastor and staff a vibrant and deepening relationship with you. Bless and protect their personal alone time with you and give them the resolve to please you and not man. Let our pastor and staff lead by first being led by you Lord. Lord, shake the hearts of people to recognize the futility of life without a personal walk with their creator.

May 2nd – <u>Focus: God's Wisdom for Decisions</u> Lord, we ask you to pour out a special anointing of wisdom, discernment, and insight on our pastor and staff. Equip them with the mind of Christ to guide all their decisions. Guide them to seek your heart and will in every decision. We pray God's people will repent from stubborn hearts, from following our own counsel and seeking the wisdom of the world to live our lives.

May 3rd – Focus: Quality Home and Family Life Father, lead our pastor in balancing the demands of his role as pastor with the role of husband and father. Bless and protect his family (call out by name) against all attacks of the enemy. Father, restore the sanctity of marriage in America, destroy the enemy's gender identity agenda, and please protect the unborn and at-risk children.

May 4th – <u>Focus: Preparation for God's Work</u> Holy Spirit, anoint our pastor's study time and provide him uninterrupted weekly sermon preparation time. Bless him with an ever-deepening understanding of God's Word and give him a special love and hunger to study and communicate the truth of your Word. Lord, we pray God's people will rightly handle your Word and be devoted to using their spiritual gifts to serve others. Lord, I ask you to give CFBC a special calling and burden to transform our community by pouring out the love of Jesus.

May 5th – Focus: Preaching God's Word

Holy Spirit, empower our pastor and associate pastors to boldly preach the full council of God's Word. May 7th – Focus: Unity in the Church

Lead our pastoral staff to protect and strengthen the unity within our body of Christ. Lord, bring conviction and restoration to churches in America that have allowed conflict to ruin their witness. Raise up godly men and women in every church who are committed to building and protecting the unity of Christ's church.

May 8th – Focus: Personal Prayer Life

Lord, make our pastor and staff people of prayer. Fill them with passion and discipline to prioritize time in prayer. Lord, increase their faith as they see your faithfulness in answered prayer. Remind us to fervently pray that our staff will be blessed with a dynamic prayer life. Lord, our nation greatly sinned by taking public prayer out of schools, businesses, and public gatherings. Lord, have mercy on us and empower your people to stand and fight to regain our freedom to pray.

May 9th – Focus: Time in God's Word

Holy Spirit, fill our pastoral staff with a deep love and hunger for the Word. Help them set aside needed time each week to read the Word. Lord speak to them through your Word. Let your Word renew their minds and spirit daily and bless them with a glimpse of your glory as they spend time with you. May 14th – Focus: Grief Ministry

Let their presence and support bring comfort even in the most difficult situations. Give them wise and compassionate words of peace and comfort for every funeral message. May 15th – Focus: Weariness

May 16th – Focus: Leadership

Father, we ask you to bless our pastor and staff with the skill and ability to handle all aspects of leading our church well. Help them leverage the unique gifts and talents each person brings. Join the hearts of the staff, elders, and deacons and bless them with a special unity to serve the body. Lord, we ask you to bless our church with trust and support for those in leadership. We pray for you to raise up godly leaders to serve our community, state, and our nation.

May 17th – Focus: Relationships

Heavenly Father, we ask you to bless and protect both employee and laity relationships in our church. Let the fruits of the spirit be evident in all relationships. Give our pastor and staff a special bond of unity. Give them wisdom and Biblical principles to guide every decision. Lord, give our church a special love for one another and let us glorify you by living out your command to put the interests of others above our own.

May 18th – Focus: Encouragement

May 19th – Focus: Courage

May 20th – Focus: Hope

Fill them with your hope, the hope of glory to serve and meet the challenges of each new day. Lord, use your Word to open our eyes so that we may know the hope to which we have been called. Forgive us when we seek hope from the world and not in you. We pray that God, the source of all hope, will give our church special zeal to spread the living hope in Christ Jesus throughout our community.

May 21st – Focus: Loss

Father, you above all know the pain of loss and rejection. We ask you to supply our pastoral staff with an extra measure of grace when they face loss, rejection, and loneliness. Let them sense your presence powerfully when they minister in death and tragedies. Bless them with friends to pray and encourage them. Lord, descend on our land with the convicting power of the Holy Spirit to bring our nation to repentance and the greatest spiritual awakening ever seen.

May 22nd – Focus: Success not Failure

Lord Jesus, help our pastoral staff focus on your definition of success and what you are leading them to do. Give them an eternal perspective and help them see and appreciate all the areas where you are at work. Give them your vision for CFBC. Keep their minds and hearts focused on pleasing you. Lord, we ask you to break the chains of worldliness that bind your church. Turn our hearts back to you and away from worthless things.

May 23rd – <u>Focus: Anger</u>

Holy Spirit, our pastoral staff often face negative comments, harsh words, and criticism through social media, emails, and phone calls. They could experience hurt or anger and we ask you to empower them to respond well. Fill them with selfcontrol to know when to respond and when to be quiet. Let all their words be seasoned with grace and bring glory to you. Lord, we pray for salvation for our lost friends and family members (call them by name).

CFBC 30-DAY PRAYER GUIDE

May 24th – Focus: Temptation

Lord, our pastoral staff, elders, and deacons are under constant spiritual attack. We ask you to daily clothe them with the protection of the armor of God. Bless them to be spiritually alert and protect them from being put in places of temptation and from yielding to temptations. Cover them with the protection of your mighty right hand. Lord, we ask you to renew our faith and confidence in you as our rock of salvation as we face unprecedented health crises, weather disasters, and political unrest.

May 25th – Focus: Comparisons

Father, we know Satan is the author of comparison. Remind our pastoral staff not to compare themselves to others but know you have gifted each perfectly to accomplish the ministry you called them to do. Admonish our church not to compare but to love, support, and pray for the staff God has given us. Lord, give us the grace to remember pastors are human and cannot be perfect. Lord, we ask you to call out more and more of our members to active involvement in serving inside and outside the church. We pray you will provide a waiting list of people willing to fill all our mission opportunities.

May 26th – <u>Focus: Joy</u>

Father, your Word tells us there is joy in your presence. We ask that our pastoral staff abide day by day in your unsurpassed goodness and fullness of joy. We pray they will count it all joy as they encounter tough times and good times. Lord, guide our pastors and staff to claim the promises in James 1:2-4. Lord, our world is full of hopeless sheep looking for safe pasture. Lord, make CFBC a place of safe pasture and a place where dozens upon dozens find living water.

May 27th – Focus: Clarity

Lord, our pastor must lead our church with a clear vision and strategy. He must make daily decisions with clarity. Lord, you are light. We ask you to give our pastor a clear vision, and light up the way he is to lead us and how he is to lead us. Gift him with the "sight" to make the right decisions for our church in these complex days. Lord, remind the people of God that the prayer of a righteous man has much power. May 28th – Focus: Friends

May 29th – Focus: Equipping

May 30th – <u>Focus: Love</u>

Lift them up, strengthen, and sustain them as they sacrificially serve and love us.
