



Position: Worship Associate

General Overview

The Worship Associate provides support to the Worship Pastor in planning, rehearsing, and executing all areas of Worship Ministry, while interacting with staff, congregational members, and the community. This is a temporary part-time position for approximately 3-6 months.

Ministry Purpose: Consistent with Romans 12:9-15 and Ephesians 4:11-12

Spiritual Responsibilities

- Seek to be a role model in attitude, speech, and actions in a consistent daily walk with Jesus Christ.
- Show by example the importance of Scripture memorization, Bible study, prayer, witnessing, and Christian fellowship.
- Be prepared to explain the church's doctrinal beliefs and practices to visitors and callers.
- Be always ready to pray with those who contact the church in need.
- Be prepared to provide Biblical/Ministry resources and assistance to those who inquire.

Essential Functions

- Support all aspects of the Worship Ministry.
- Serves on Music/Worship Ministry Leadership team
- Serves as substitute director of worship choir, vocal team, praise band and other ensembles when Worship Pastor is absent.
- Coordinates and oversees all instrumental music and hired musicians for special events (Celebration Sunday Nights, Christmas program, Nights of Worship, Worship Service, etc.)
- Work with Worship Pastor to select songs that are biblically and theologically sound, congregationally singable, and appropriate
- Would serve as instrumental director and oversee the creation and direction of the future orchestra.
- Equips and trains student praise team and worship band.
- Assist Worship Pastor in kids and youth choir.
- Other duties or special projects, as needed.

Qualifications:

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree: a post-graduate degree in music preferred.
- Proper musical training is a must.



- Trustworthy with vigilance towards confidentiality in all matters especially with pastoral conversations, and sensitive personal and shared information between members
- Ability to work independently with some supervision.
- Have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Agree to uphold the Church's statement of faith, and be willing to submit to the standards outlined in the Personnel Manual
